1. You are invited to submit your most competitive quotation for the following goods with item wise detailed specifications given at Annexure I,

Government of India has received a credit from the International Development Association (IDA) towards the cost of the Technical Education Quality Improvement Programme[TEQIP]-Phase II Project and intends to apply part of the proceeds of this credit to eligible payments under the contract for which this invitation for quotations is issued.
3. Quotation,
 - 3.1 The contract shall be for the full quantity as described above.
 - 3.2 Corrections, if any, shall be made by crossing out, initialing, dating and re writing.

3.3 All duties and other levies payable by the supplier under the contract shall be distinctively shown along with the unit price.

3.4 Applicable taxes shall be quoted separately for all items.

3.5 The prices quoted by the bidder shall be fixed for the duration of the contract and shall not be subject to adjustment on any account.

3.6 The Prices should be quoted in Indian Rupees only.

4. Each bidder shall submit only one quotation.

5. Quotation shall remain valid for a period not less than 55 days after the last date of quotation submission.

6. Evaluation of Quotations,

The Purchaser will evaluate and compare the quotations determined to be substantially responsive i.e. which

6.1 are properly signed ; and

6.2 confirm to the terms and conditions, and specifications.

7. The Quotations would be evaluated for all items together.

8. Award of contract:

The Purchaser will award the contract to the bidder whose quotation has been determined to be substantially responsive and who has offered the lowest evaluated quotation price.

8.1 Notwithstanding the above, the Purchaser reserves the right to accept or reject any quotations and to cancel the bidding process and reject all quotations at any time prior to the award of contract.

8.2 The bidder whose bid is accepted will be notified of the award of contract by the Purchaser prior to expiration of the quotation validity period. The terms of the accepted offer shall be incorporated in the purchase order.

9. Payment shall be made in Indian Rupees as follows:

Delivery and Installation - 90% of total cost

Satisfactory Acceptance - 10% of total cost

10. All supplied items are under warranty of 12 months from the date of successful commissioning.

11. You are requested to provide your offer latest by 02:30 hours on 15-Apr-2015 .
12. Training Clause (if any) NIL
13. Testing/Installation Clause (if any) Installation & testing as per scope of work.
14. The vendor, if desires may visit the site with prior information to the undersigned, for estimation of quantum of work involved.
15. The quote should clearly mention the costs involved under various heads including the labour cost. The contract will be awarded to a single party only on lump sum basis and there will be no splitting of the contract.
16. If the supplier fails to deliver any or all of the goods or to perform the services within the period(s) specified in the contract, the purchaser shall deduct from the contract price, as liquidated damaged (LD), a sum equivalent to the percentage of 0.07% per week with the maximum deduction at 10% of the contract price. In case supplier delays the completion even beyond the date up to which LD 10% becomes due, the purchaser may consider termination of the contract.
17. Information brochures/ Product catalogue, if any, must be accompanied with the quotation clearly indicating the model quoted for.

Scope of work

1. Vendor to dismantle all the piping and accessories existing at site.
2. Replacement of steam pipeline and its accessories as existing at site in Dr. SSBUI CET, PU, Chd. (Vendor should visit the site for estimation).
3. Vendor to install new pipelines and its accessories.
4. Vendor to repair all the damages done to civil work while removing the existing pipelines and or placing the new one.
5. Insulation to be provided on the pipes, wherever required.
6. Pressure testing and leak test to be done on site and necessary safety certificate to be provided.
7. The vendor to demonstrate the successful operation of the system to the satisfaction of inspection committee.
8. Enclosed is the bill of material (Annexure-1) which is tentative in nature. Vendor to make its own assessment as per the available site.
9. Notwithstanding anything, the vendor is responsible for taking all the actions for successful commissioning of the system.
10. Vendor has to make his own arrangement for lodging of skilled/ unskilled manpower.
11. Water and electricity will be provided by the department. Moreover, oil required for demonstration (approx 4 barrels) will be provided by the vendor.
