Members of the Faculty of Engineering & Technology in its meeting held on March 28<sup>th</sup>, 2015, Saturday at 12 noon in the Senate Hall, Panjab University, Chandigarh unanimously recommended as under :

1. Dr. Harish Kumar from UIET suggested that Thesis Evaluation criteria is different in some M.E./M.Tech courses and there should be uniformity in all M.E./M.Tech courses in all Institutes/Colleges.

Members unanimously decided that criteria for evaluation of thesis should be same in Grading and it should be implemented in all the institutes/colleges of all M.E./M.Tech Courses which is as under:-

**Instructions for Examiners to award marks/grades for thesis from the session 2015-16:-**

S.No.	Grade	Condition
1.	A+	Publication from Thesis in SCI indexed journal
2.	A	Publication from Thesis in Scopus indexed journal
3.	B+	Publication from Thesis in proceedings of Conferences which is Scopus indexed.
4.	B	Presented paper in International Conference
5.	C+	Presented paper in National Conference

2. Dean Faculty of Engg. & Technology informed following to the members about **Branch Sliding:**

1. In the first year of BE program students of various branches study different subjects including branch specific elective. So, it has been decided that branch sliding can be allowed only within the branches, where students study same set of subjects in the 1<sup>st</sup> year.
2. The branch sliding will be permissible within the institute only and not intra institute.
3. The students shall normally pursue the respective B.E. Programmes allocated to them at the time of admission. However, a limited number of academically meritorious students, as assessed by their performance in the institute at the end of first year may be permitted, to change their branch as per norms given below:
  - a. Such change will be considered only once at the end of second semester. All such transfers can be effected only once at the beginning of the second Academic Year of the students. No application for the change of branch will be entertained during the subsequent academic years.
  - b. Only those students will be eligible for consideration for the change of branch who were admitted against normal seats excluding (supernumerary seats and the seats for NRI Category students) and have successfully completed the first year two semesters with CGPA > 9.00 without any back log i.e. pending reappears.
